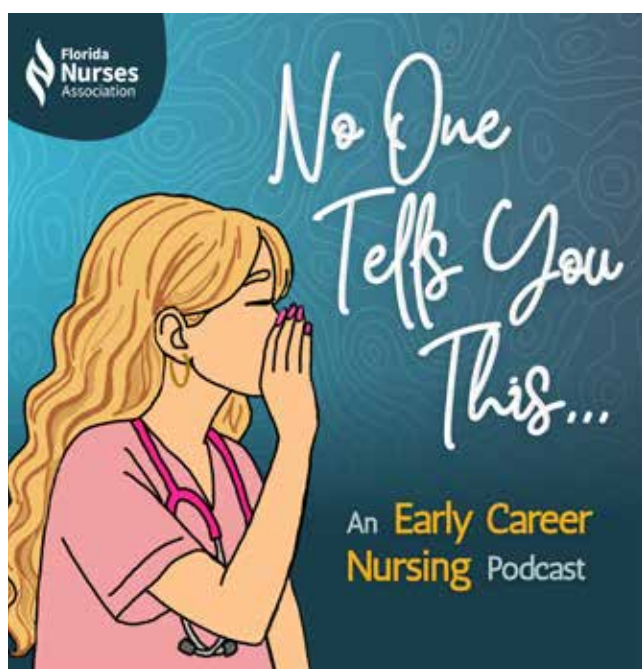
Taking the time to nominate a colleague is a powerful way to acknowledge the work that often goes unseen—the compas-
